

# Sustainable Tours

A journey to enjoy the island with locals and help preserve their way of life.



On Okinoerabu Island, you can participate in an interactive world that allows you to experience environmentally friendly practices. Meet guides who are making a positive impact to protect the marine environment, and interact with them while cleaning the beach together. Afterwards, you can also enjoy an upcycling experience where plastic waste is transformed into goods with new value.

The Okinoerabu Island Tourism Association has a special machine that can recycle plastic into a variety of goods. Currently, coasters, key chains, and accessory parts are available. Visitors can decide what to make by consulting with a guide on the day of the tour.

If you want to learn more about the environment and experience nature in this area, we recommend that you participate in a beach cleanup activity with a local guide. You will learn about positive efforts to protect this island.

You can also participate in yoga on the beautiful beach after the beach cleanup to experience the nature of the island with a greater sense of clarity.
